

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**PY 2026 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds
Community Development Allocation and Neighborhood Revitalization
Programs Miami County, Ohio**

The Board of Miami County Commissioners intends to apply to the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) for funding under the Program Year 2026 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Critical Infrastructure program; a federally funded program administered by the State of Ohio. Miami County is eligible for \$1,500,000.00 of Critical Infrastructure Program funding provided the County meets applicable program requirements. On April 16, 2026, Miami County conducted its first public hearing to inform citizens about all CDBG programs which are available, how funds may be used, what activities are eligible, and other important program requirements.

Based on both citizen input and local official’s assessments of the County’s needs, Miami County is proposing to undertake the following CDBG Critical Infrastructure Program activities for Program Year 2026:

The application deadline is June 10, 2026.

The Miami County Safety Building is a handicapped accessible facility.
